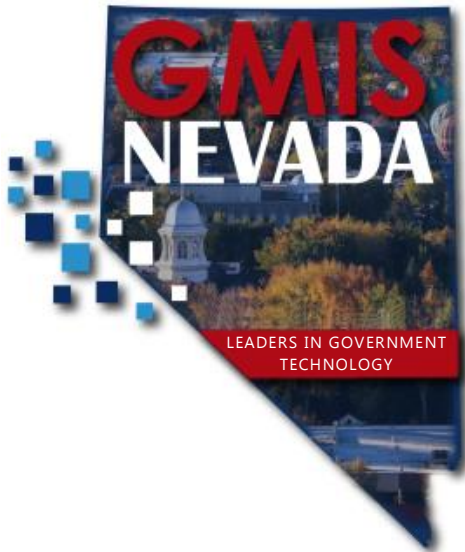


Nevada GMIS Chapter
